

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6. Installation of a timeware® client

All information pertaining to any personnel record within this document is obtained from a demonstration database and are not details of any individual.




Installation of a timeware® client

- First and foremost when installing a client version of timeware® you are required to know the exact version of timeware® used on the timeware® server. If the versions were to be incorrect then there will be an incompatibility between them and the client would not be able to function (15.1.0 isn't compatible with 15.1.1). This can be found by going to the help/about screen on timeware®.
- Once the version is established, the correct installation file needs to be located. The
 installation files are named 'tp" followed by the version eg 'tp150101" and most likely
 can be found on your server. If not however, please contact timeware® support on 01706
 658 222. The very latest versions of timeware® can be found at www.timeware.org





 Right click on the installation file and run as administrator. It may ask you to input the administrator credentials if not logged on with an administrative account but this is required.






• You will be presented with an installation wizard. Click next and then you will be required to accept a licence agreement. Once you are happy to accept the agreement, click Yes.








• In the next screen there is an option to select either a 'Complete" or 'Custom" installation. The complete installation is all the components for a timeware® server, so make sure to choose the custom installation.






• Click next, then Select the installation path you require the software to be installed into (default is C:\Program Files (x86)\timeware Software\timeware)







• After clicking next, you will be presented with the options of what to install. Un-tick the server option and click next. This is so you do not install the server portion of the timeware® software which is not required for a client installation and will cause issues further down the line.





• Click next and wait for the installation to complete. Once it completes the installation click finish.







We now need to get the software connecting to the SQL database which can be simply done by copy and pasting a file from the server to the client PC. The file itself is called 'SQLConnection.ini" and can be found in the following location (C:\Program Files (x86)\ timeware Software\timeware\TData) on the server. Simply transfer the sql file onto the client PC and paste it into the same location above. Alternatively, if you know the SQL credentials simply go through the SQL wizard provided when you run the timeware® software.



 The software will now be able to be used by the client and is safe for the customer to log on.
